# accommodations

## event registration

All contestants and attendees of the Impact Expo should submit an individual or group registration form. The Impact Expo event fees are as follows:

Event fees may be purchased at the box office the day of the event, however it is recommended that large groups pre-register to expedite box office check in.

## contestant orientation

All contestants should arrive at the Long Center Theatre for orientation at 6:30pm on Friday March 5, 2010. All contestants participating in a Performing Category will meet in the auditorium with contestant coordinator Dawna Woolf.

Contestants participating in a Non Performing Category will meet in the theatre lounge with contestant coordinator Brooke Underwood. Should a contestant be registered in both categories, a representative should fill in for them. At least one representative is required for group entries, i.e. the entire group does not have to be present. Contestants not showing for orientation will be disqualified from the expo.
